Union Council Elections

This Union Notes:

1. That last year Union Council elections were moved from May to October
2. That this meant there were no elected Officers available during the summer period
3. That crucial CUSU events and campaigns are planned over the summer period

This Union Believes:

1. That Union Council Officers' input is essential in planning events and campaigns
2. That having no elected Officers over the summer period is detrimental to the organisation
3. That the first term of the academic year is the busiest with a vast array of events and campaigns occurring

This Union Resolves:

1. To move the Union Council election dates back to May
2. To amend the Constitution as follows:
 - Appendix D, section 2 – Delete and replace with 'The term of office for Executive positions and Union Council Officers shall be from 1 July to 30 June unless the Union Council decides otherwise for specific reasons'
 - Appendix D, section 3 – Delete 'October' and replace with 'May'
