Promoting the Annual General Meeting of CUSU

This Union Notes:

1. That the Annual General Meeting (“AGM”) is the sovereign body of Coventry University Students’ Union (“CUSU”)
2. The AGM is required to approve the accounts of CUSU for the year
3. The quoracy of the AGM is 100
4. Lecturers are required to cancel lectures during the hours of the AGM

This Union Believes:

1. The AGM is vital to promote the active role of CUSU and increasing student involvement in the organisation
2. The AGM should be more heavily promoted that it currently is
3. Failure to have a quorate AGM is disastrous for CUSU
4. The Executive Committee and Union Council Officers should take an active role in promoting the AGM to the student body

This Union Resolves:

1. To mandate the Executive Committee to set up, co-ordinate and participate in a campaign to promote attendance to the AGM within a minimum of two weeks before the date of the yearly AGM
2. To mandate the Union Council Officers to actively participate in this campaign
3. To mandate the VP Communications to promote the AGM through Source Media and to contact University lecturers informing them of the AGM date and the requirement to cancel lectures
4. To mandate the Executive Committee to ‘name and shame’ lecturers who do not cancel lectures for the AGM following the yearly meeting
