Budget for Faculty Chairs

This Union Notes:

1. School/Faculty Chairs have no budget of their own to work with, and are the only members of the Executive without money set aside for this
2. School/Faculty Chairs have a responsibility to their students to make themselves known and to improve the student experience as much as possible

This Union Believes:

1. School/Faculty Chairs are limited in the type and size of events that they can organise for their students, due to the absence of funds
2. Schools and Faculties have a responsibility to create a public identity to better support their students
3. Schools and Faculties should provide this budget in recognition of the work that School/Faculty Chairs do for their specific cohort of students and the role they play in improving the student experience

This Union Resolves:

1. To mandate the Executive to ask Schools and Faculties to provide their chairs with a budget
2. That there is to be a foundation budget to be available per academic year, uniformed across all Schools and Faculties
3. That there is a budget negotiated between the School or Faculty chair and the Dean of each School or Faculty at the beginning of each term so that the chair can apply for extra funding for projects
