### **This Union Notes:**

1. The Current Provision of Sports Facilities in the University is over subscribed.
2. The University has a strategy for the development of Estates including Sporting Facilities.

### **This Union Believes:**

1. Development in both performance and participation is currently being hindered by the provision of facilities.
2. Comparatively; more can be achieved in the increasing of Sporting Facilities than investment in other areas.
3. With potentially higher tuition fees, the expectation for student experience and facilities will be higher.
4. Due to Health and wellbeing benefits, the University should increase development of Sports provision.

### **This Union Resolves:**

1. That the Students' Union shall recognise and promote the importance of physical activity to the health and wellbeing of students.
2. That the Students' Union should support the plans proposed by 'Sport and Recreation' for the development of the Sport Centre.
3. To mandate the Vice President Student Activities to:
  - Lobby the University to put Sports Facilities first in any plans for Campus development.
