

# A201CAR - UNDERSTANDING CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

## MODULE SUMMARY

The aim of this module is to develop and enhance students' employability and to help them to make the transition into the highly competitive graduate employment market, postgraduate study, or further training opportunities.

Students will explore their skills and identify areas for development, become aware of the skills required by graduate employers and develop ways in which they can demonstrate their skills to employers. The complexities of the modern graduate employment market will be explored. Students will also benefit from four sessions on communication skills as well as sessions on applying for jobs, how to create a good curriculum vitae and information on assessment centres.
