Using your experiences of teaching and learning in school, this module offers an introduction to the mentoring skills necessary to become an effective communicator and teacher. The module will allow you (as the mentor) to establish a rapport with students, thus enabling you to recognise success and achievements in others, offer constructive feedback and provide advice and support where necessary. The module stresses the importance of planning and provides you with the opportunity to reflect upon your classroom experiences.
